

# Propane Safety Rules

- No smoking
- No strikers in the fueling area.
- Proper gloves must be worn during fueling.
- Tanks must be filled one at a time.
- Only two experienced persons per vehicle in the fueling area
- Only experienced personnel accompanying the balloon shall fuel.
- No one is allowed in the gondola or vehicle during fueling.
- All electronic devices must be turned off in the fueling area.
- Pilot lights and all other sources of ignition in recreational type vehicles must be turned off while in the fueling area.
- Vehicle engines must be turned off during fueling.
- The front vehicle windows must be lowered in the fueling area.
- Pickups must lower their tailgates during the fueling process.
- Vans and trailers must have all doors open during fueling.
- Vans and trailers without proper ventilation (side doors) must remove gondola from enclosed areas during fueling.
- No artificial material clothing (e.g. nylon) may be worn in fueling area.
- Flags must be taken down and stowed before entering the fueling area.
- Gondola covers must be completely removed prior to fueling.
- Loose items must be stowed before fueling to prevent chance of static discharge.
- No animals or pets of any kind are permitted in the fueling area.
- No alcoholic beverages may be consumed anywhere in the fueling area.
- Persons believed to be intoxicated must not be allowed to fuel.
- Only “hazardous location approved” trailer dome lights or “hazardous location approved” flashlights may be used during night fueling.
